Churnet Valley Railway trip

As you are aware, Year 5 will be taking part in an Evacuee Day at Churnet Valley Railway in Leek, Staffordshire. We now have further details, which are included below:

Dates each class will attend:

Monday 5th March 2018 – 5MS
Monday 12th March 2018 – 5HC
Monday 19th March 2018 – 5JY

Clothing:

Children are asked, where possible, to dress appropriately for the era (1940's). Boys can wear trousers or shorts with long tucked-in socks and a shirt and jumper. Girls could wear skirts and a shirt or a dress. We would suggest searching images on Google for some ideas. All children will need to bring a warm outdoor jacket.

Lunches:

Children who have free school dinners, will have a lunch provided by the kitchen staff. Children who bring packed lunches are asked to bring them in a disposable carrier bag and not to include fizzy drinks or family sized crisps/sweets.

Departure and return times:

Due to the experience being in Leek, we will need to leave school at 8.00 am prompt. All children will need to be at school by 7.50 am at the latest and enter the building via the main hall gate. We should arrive back at school by 4.00 pm at the latest, but this will be confirmed on the return journey.
