Year 5 Educational Visit to Churnet Valley Railway

As an integral part of study for our forthcoming theme, 'Children of War', we have provisionally booked an educational visit to Churnet Valley Railway, Froghall, for next half term. Churnet Valley Railway is recognised as a valuable educational resource for students of all ages. The day will consist of; the children taking part in an evacuee auction, travelling on a 10 mile round train trip on a heritage locomotive, using their ration book and tasting wartime recipes, training to be a member of The Royal Observer Corps and experiencing a Blackout in an Air Raid Shelter. These are just a few of the activities the children will have the opportunity to take part in, during their immersion into life as an evacuee in wartime Britain. We would also encourage that the children dress suitably for the day's activities.

To ensure that our children can be comfortably accommodated, and receive the best experience, the trip will take place on three separate days: **Monday 5th March, Monday 12th March and Monday 19th March.** We will inform you nearer the time on which date your child will be travelling and of other arrangements for the day.
