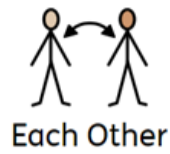


# St Anthony's Catholic Primary School Behaviour Policy

## In EYFS, we Respect:



### Positive Choices

We celebrate positive choices in a variety of ways:



- Share your good news with any adult
- Add your picture to the Class Respect Star
- Choose a very special 'Mission Star' each week
- Class 'Star of the Week'
- Stickers as instant rewards

### Poor Choices

Step 1	An adult will remind you of our Respect Rules
Step 2	An adult will give you 'reflection time' during 'loving to learn time' to think about choices made 3 minutes in Nursery and 5 minutes in Reception of your own time
Step 3	3 minutes on the other side of Nursery and 5 minutes in another Reception class A restorative conversation is had with the child using the 'Reflect and Reset' sheet

After every session (morning, lunch, end of day), **we start fresh** because our school believes in forgiveness.

### Lunch

We use Yellow and Red Cards



Verbal Warning	Yellow Card	Red Card
<p>Verbal Warning: "This is your first warning; please stop ----."</p> <p>Remind the child of our Respect Values</p>	<p>Yellow Card: A formal warning to stop.</p>	<p>A verbal warning and a yellow card then leads to a red card.</p> <p>Red card = 5 minutes away from play (at the side or with a staff member).</p> <p>If this happens at the end of break, the time is taken next break</p> <p>If Red Cards are ignored: Involve class teacher/ SLT for support</p>
