



## Spelling Curriculum: Year 5

### Autumn 1

- Revision of the suffix -ly (Year 4)
- Words ending -cious and -tious
- Words ending in -ible and -able
- Words ending in -ibly and -ably

#### **CEW Word List:**

ancient, attached, average, bargain, bruise, category, cemetery, committee, communicate, community, criticise, curiosity

### Autumn 2

- Revision of Year 4 words ending -tion, -sion, -ssion, -cian
- Words ending in -cial and -tial
- Words containing the letter-string ough

#### **CEW Word List:**

definite, develop, dictionary, conscious, equip, equipped, equipment, familiar, foreign, forty, government, harass

### Spring 1

- Words ending in -ant / -ance / -ancy
- Words ending in -ent, / -ence / -ency

#### **CEW Word List:**

frequently, yacht, immediate, immediately, language, leisure, lightning, marvellous, mischievous, muscle, neighbour, parliament

### Spring 2

- Homophones (commonly confused nouns and verbs): advice / advise, device / devise, licence / license, practice / practise, prophecy / prophesy
- Adding suffixes beginning with vowel letters to words ending in -fer



- Further homophones: profit / prophet, who's / whose, principle / principal, steal / steel, past / passed

## CEW Word List:

occupy, occur, physical, prejudice, privilege, queue, rhyme, rhythm, soldier, stomach, symbol, system

## Summer 1

- Homophones: desert / dessert, guessed / guest, heard / herd, led / lead, weary / wary
- Words with the /i:/ sound spelt ei after c
- Words with silent letters

## CEW Word List:

temperature, thorough, twelfth, vegetable

Explicitly teach CEW where less confidence is shown.

## Summer 2

*The aim of the Summer 2 curriculum is to revise and consolidate content from the year that children have found challenging. This should be determined by the teacher's ongoing assessment throughout the year (and informed by the progress tests).*

- Homophones: stationary / stationery, precede / proceed, cereal / serial, aloud / allowed, altar / alter
- Revision of the suffix -ation
- Revision of the suffix -ous (Year 4)
- Revision of homophones covered so far
